Maths Problem Solving

Emma takes 4 steps every 5 seconds as she walks into the cave. If she walks for 2 minutes, how many steps does she take in total?

The entrance of the cave is 8 meters wide and 5 meters tall. What is the total area of the cave entrance in square meters?
